## ENTRY OF CONDITIONS

All Handlers must be members of ASEA. Day membership is available for all non-members at [www.smallequine.com.au](http://www.smallequine.com.au) \$10 per single, \$20 per family. All horses must hold current registrations with ASEA or any other recognised Society. Registered purebred horses are entitled to enter height classes. All entrants must familiarise themselves with our show rules and code of conduct prior to attending.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Entries must be emailed to [aseagoldcoast@gmail.com](mailto:aseagoldcoast@gmail.com)
- Closing time for entries is midnight on Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2024
- All sections of the entry forms MUST BE completed, including signing the show rules waiver.
- Copies of registration papers (front and back) MUST BE provided for each horse/pony you enter in the show.
- Pending registrations from Associations other than ASEA will not be permitted.
- All payments must be received by midnight Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 (please provide receipt number)
- No refunds or credits will be given other than in extenuation circumstances, subject to Committee approval

## OFFICIAL MEASURING TIMES

There will be no measuring at this Show. You are required to know your horse's current height and show within the applicable height category.

## PROTESTS

Competitors, Exhibitors, or any Show Official have the option to file a protest. The protest must be submitted within a timeframe of THIRTY (30) MINUTES after the conclusion of the class. To validate the protest, a cash sum of \$50.00 must be submitted, with a refund available if the protest is deemed valid.

## CODE OF ETHICS, CONDUCT AND BULLYING

*Violations of this code may result in serious consequences under the Constitution. All Spectators, Competitors, and Committee Members must adhere to conduct criteria below at ASEA events:*

- Refrain from public disparagement.
- Respect all others.
- Avoid intimidating or degrading behaviour.
- Exhibit fairness, respect, and consideration.
- Never engage in any form of bullying.
- Avoid interference with others' property.
- Demonstrate integrity and responsibility.
- Prioritise horse welfare over competition.
- Maintain exemplary conduct on show grounds and in the ring.
- Must not influence Judges and appointed Judges decisions
- Competitors must remain in class until winners have been sashed.
- Encourage genuine applause without compromising fair competition.

If there is a gear or handler change, please notify the Gate Steward. All equipment required for gear and handler changes must be brought to the marshaling area to ensure classes run efficiently. No thongs, sandals or Ugg boots are to be worn in the marshaling area. PLEASE make sure you monitor the progress of the classes and are on time for. Once your name has been marked off on the marshaling sheet, you will be regarded as present and ready for your class. DO NOT leave the designated marshaling area as you will not be recalled.

1. **Acknowledge that a horse or pony may**, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddles or bridles may loosen or break – all of which may cause the rider and/or handler to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death.
2. **Acknowledge that horseback riding is an inherently dangerous activity** and involves risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases, death. Because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behaviour of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.
3. **Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury** or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear provided by me
4. **Release, discharge and promise not to sue** any ASEA State or National Committee Member, Show Organiser or Show Volunteer, doing business under its own name or any other name and/or any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damages, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.
5. **Release the Releasees** from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding and/or handling experience or ability including but not limited to, training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction, riding or handling/leading skills and supervising riders.
6. **Indemnify, and save and hold harmless** the owner, instructors, its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment of gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of wranglers or other employees or agents.
7. **The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the relevant State/Territory of Australia** and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by Australian State and Federal Law (**RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK**), and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.
8. **Acknowledge that this document is a contract** and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against ASEA Inc Show Organisers, National/State Committee Members, its agents and/or volunteers for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the fore mentioned in defending such an action.
9. **State that I am not now pregnant** and that I have no history of epileptic seizures, heart condition or any other medical problem that could be affected by horseback riding.
10. **IT IS REQUIRED THAT MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET MUST BE WORN AND A CONDITION OF PARTICIPATING IN ANY AND ALL ASEA Inc RIDDEN CLASSES/SHOWS**
11. If the person who is to enter into this Agreement is less than eighteen (18) years of age, his/her parent or guardian must read this Agreement and sign below on the behalf of the minor.

I have read this entire Waiver Document. I understand it is a promise not to sue and to release all owners, volunteers and ASEA Representatives for all claims.
