- All Handlers must be members of ASEA. Day membership is available for all non members at www.smallequine.com.au \$10 per single, \$20 per family
- All exhibitors MUST be a current Financial Member of AMR to compete in the Youngstock Double shot. Day membership is \$15 per day.
- All members of ASEA Inc shall accept and be bound by these rules.
- Making an entry for any event constitutes implicit acceptance of the Show Rules of ASEA.
- Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with these rules. It remains the full responsibility of the **Owner**/ Handler to comply with the equipment rules as outlined.
- Breaches of these rules may entail consequences. These Rules must be read in conjunction with ASEA Inc Constitution.
- Should any issue arise with regards to the interpretation of any Show Rule it shall be referred to the ASEA Inc Committee for determination. The ASEA Inc Committee will determine what interpretation is to be given and this decision will be binding and no appeal or protest will be permitted.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SHOWING

- All horses must be registered with either ASEA Inc. or an approved ASEA recognised Equine Association/Society if accepted.
- Owners/Members and all Handlers must be current financial Member of ASEA Inc. (Competitors must read Conditions of Entries attached to advertised Show Entries).
- For any ASEA Inc show, copies of registration papers must be provided with entry forms if registered with a society/association other than ASEA Inc.
- Horses may only compete in classes for the section of which they meet the height for age requirements, with the exception of Purebred Miniature/Appendix Ponies who may only compete in their own breed sections, unless otherwise advertised by Committee.
- All entries must be made by the owner/lessee of the horses or ponies. The owner/lessee entering the horse must be a financial member of ASEA Inc. with which the exhibit is registered and proof of such is to be supplied with entries.
- To enter an ASEA Inc show, the owner/ lessee must use the complete name and registration number of the horse or pony as it is shown on the registration certificate.
- Pending registration for other societies will NOT be accepted.
- All entrants must familiarize themselves with our show rules and code of conduct prior to attending.

CODE OF ETHICS, CONDUCT AND BULLYING

Violations of this code may result in serious consequences under the Constitution. All, including Spectators, competitors, and Committee Members, must adhere to conduct criteria below at ASEA events:

- a. Refrain from public disparagement.
- b. Respect all others.
- c. Avoid intimidating or degrading behaviour.
- d. Exhibit fairness, respect, and consideration.
- e. Never engage in any form of bullying.
- f. Avoid interference with others' property.

- g. Demonstrate integrity and responsibility.
- h. Prioritize horse welfare over competition.
- i. Maintain exemplary conduct on show grounds and in the ring.
- j. Must not influence Judges and appointed Judges decisions
- k. Competitors must remain in class until winners have been sashed.
 - Encourage genuine applause without compromising fair competition.

Show terms and Conditions

In consideration for allowing me (or my minor child) to handle and ride a horse and on behalf of myself, my child or our personal representatives, spouses and any other person authorised by me, I HEREBY:

1. Acknowledge that a horse or pony may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddles or bridles may loosen or break – all of which may cause the rider and/or handler to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death.

2. Acknowledge that horseback riding is an inherently dangerous activity and involves risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases, death. Because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behaviourof horses, regardless of their training and past performance.

3. Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear provided by me

4. Release, discharge and promise not to sue any ASEA State or National Committee Member, Show Organiser or Show Volunteer, doing business under its own name or any other name and/or any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damages, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.

Release the Releasees from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding and/or handling experience or ability including but not limited to, training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction, riding or handling/leading skills and supervising riders.

Indemnify, and save and hold harmless the owner, instructors, its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment of gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of wranglers or other employees or agents.
 7. The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the relevant State/Territory of Australia and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by Australian State and Federal Law (RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK), and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.

8. Acknowledge that this document is a contract and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against ASEA Inc Show Organisers, National/State Committee Members, its agents and/or volunteers for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the fore mentioned in defending such an action.

9. State that I am not now pregnant and that I have no history of epileptic seizures, heart condition or any other medical problem that could be affected by horseback riding.
10. IT IS REQUIRED THAT MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET MUST BE WORN AND A CONDITION OF PARTICIPATING IN ANY AND ALL ASEA Inc RIDDEN CLASSES/SHOWS

11. If the person who is to enter into this Agreement is less than eighteen (18) years of age, his/her parent or guardian must read this Agreement and sign below on the behalf of the minor.
